What's Required to Volunteer

- Minimum of 6 months in Al-Anon.
- Regularly attend meetings.
- Commit to answer calls for one week each month, along with four other volunteers.
- Have a computer with internet service or a cell phone.
- Be comfortable navigating ga-al-anon.org for meeting information.
